Sydney–Canberra route map

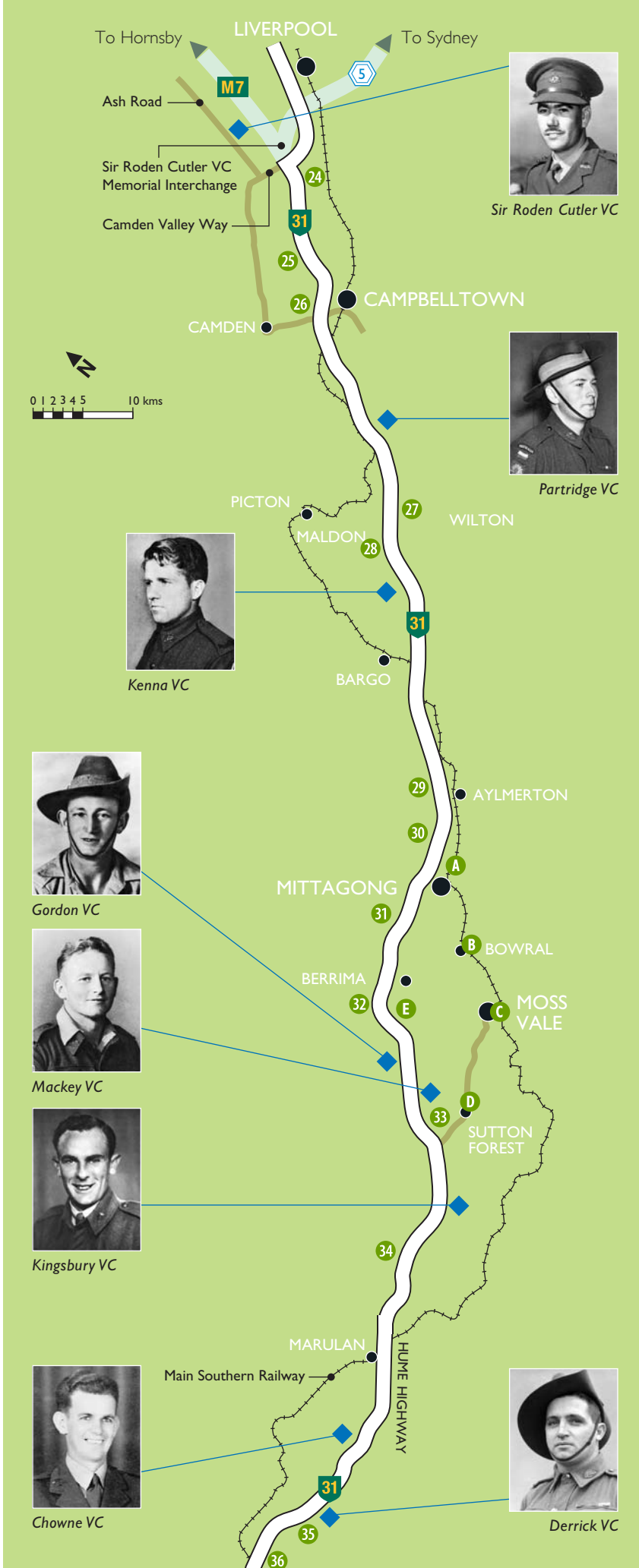


- 1 **Macquarie Place:** Two *Plane Trees* planted by Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II and His Royal Highness the Duke of Edinburgh in 1954 to mark the Sydney end of the Driveway.
- 2 **South Strathfield:** Landscaped plantations of 5000 *Eucalyptus* species, *Acacias*, *Casuarinas* and *Grevilleas*. Planted by Strathfield Council in 1990.
- 3 **Chullora:** An established avenue of trees and *Grevilleas* on the north side of the Hume Highway.
- 4 **Winsor Park:** A small park planted by State Rail with *Eucalyptus* species and *Kaffir Plums* in 1955, upgraded with 150 *Eucalyptus* species and *Ficus* in 1995.
- 5 **Bass Hill:** *Lemon Scented Gums* planted in 1957 by Qantas. Upgraded in 1993 with 166 *Lemon Scented Gums*, *Tallowwoods* and *Plane Trees*.
- 6 **Bass Hill:** *Fig Trees* and *Poplars* planted in 1962 and *Lemon Scented Gums* planted by the BCOF Veterans Association in 1992.
- 7 **Bass Hill, Gregory Street:** *Lemon Scented Gums* planted in 1993 and dedicated as 18 Brigade Memorial Park.
- 8 **Bass Hill, Hector Street:** Walshaw Park. *Sydney Red Gums* planted by Leyland Australia in 1962, and the War Widows plantation dedicated in 2007.
- 9 **Bass Hill, Johnston Road:** On the south side of the Hume Highway a plantation of *Melaleucas* established in 1965 and upgraded with 500 new trees in 1994-95.
- 10 **Bass Hill Plaza:** Memorial Garden established in 1996 with additional trees planted to Arundle Road.
- 11 **Bass Hill, Arundle Road:** A small plantation of *Eucalyptus* species and *Casuarinas*.
- 12 **Bass Hill, Berridale Estate:** *Eucalyptus* species planted in 1967 were virtually destroyed by building operations, but replanted with *Melaleucas*, *Spotted Gums* and *Turpentines* in 1970.
- 13 **Villawood:** From Miller Road to Woodville Road a long avenue of *Spotted Gums* with mixed tree species at each end planted in 1962. Includes 504 *Spotted Gums* and *Grey Boxes* planted in 1992 as Vietnam Veterans Memorial plantation.
- 14 **Villawood, Burke Square:** A plantation of 450 *Eucalyptus* species, *Australian Figs* and some exotic species established in 1957.
- 15 **Lansdowne Bridge, Centre Islands:** A fine stand of *Spotted Gums* and *Red Flowering Ironbarks* planted in 1958.
- 16 **Lansdowne Bridge, Eastern Side:** A large park of *Eucalyptus* species, *Pines* and various deciduous and evergreen trees planted in 1962.
- 17 **Lennox Reserve:** A landscaped park of *Pines*, *Poplars* and *Paperbarks* established in 1960.
- 18 **Cabramatta, Huntingdale Avenue:** A small park of *Mugga Ironbarks* established in 1973.
- 19 **Cabramatta:** A park of *Chinese Elms*, *Liquidambars* and *Bunya Pines* planted by the Garden Club of Australia in 1955.
- 20 **Cabramatta:** A small park between Old Liverpool Road and the Highway planted with *Eucalyptus* species and *Casuarinas* in 1979.
- 21 **Warwick Farm:** Landscaped gardens and plantations tended by Peter Warren Motors and Masterton Homes.
- 22 **Liverpool, Berryman Reserve:** A plantation of *Eucalyptus* species, *Turpentines*, *Pines* and *Poplars* at Warwick Farm Railway Station established in 1956.
- 23 **Casula:** Two plantations of 400 *Eucalyptus* species established in 1991 by Liverpool City Council.

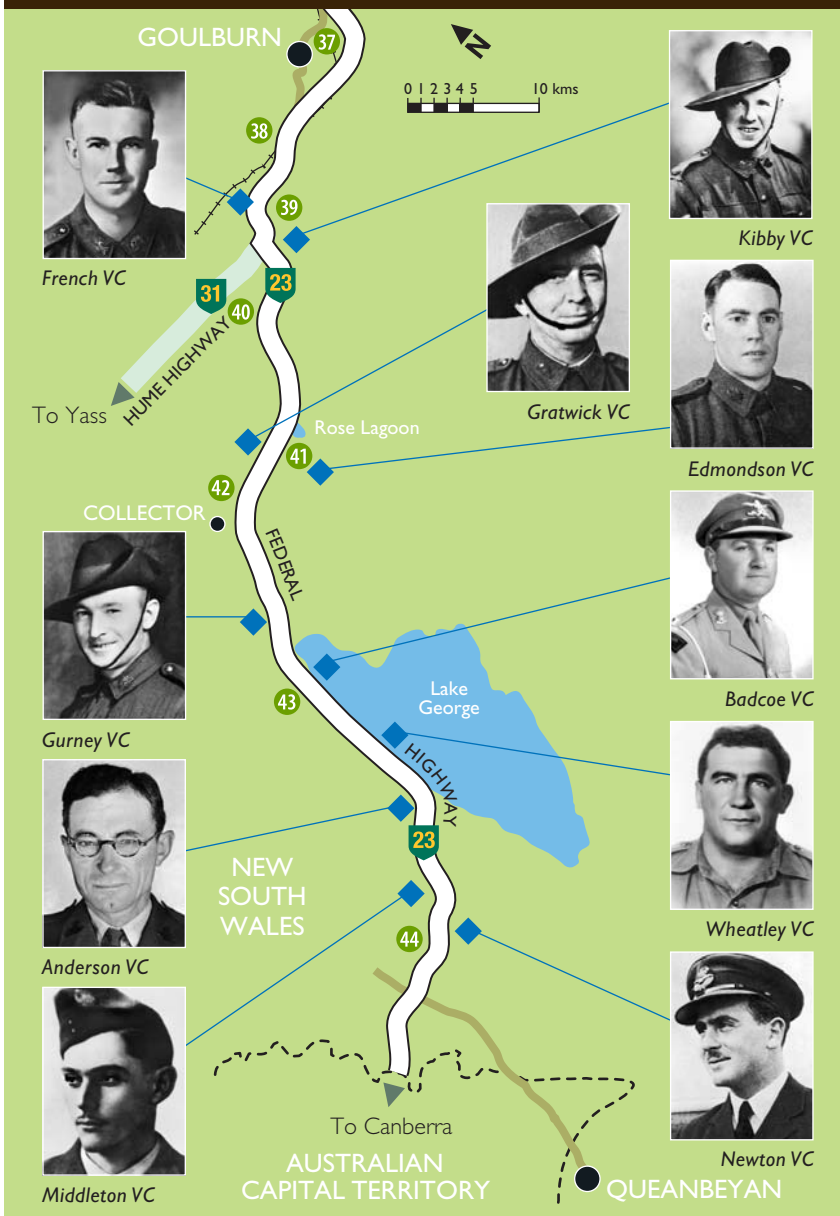


- ◆ Sir Roden Cutler VC Rest Area established 2006.
- 24 Ingleburn: A plantation of 140 *Eucalyptus* species at the Campbelltown Road overbridge on the M5. Planted in 1992 by 6 Division Association. The Australian Defence Force Memorial Plantation is planned for dedication in 2010. It will be established on both verges and the median strip of the freeway between the Campbelltown Rd entry ramp [near the Camden Valley Way overpass] and the Brooks Rd Bridge, Campbelltown. It will consist of some 50,000 *Spotted Gums*, *Forest Red Gums*, *Narrow Leaved Red Ironbarks*, *Grey Boxes*, *Paperbarks*, *Wattles* and *She Oaks*. The plantation will honour those members of the Defence Force who serve in the post Vietnam War era.
- 25 Australian Defence Force Memorial Plantation: This plantation extends between Camden Valley Way and Mount Annan Botanic gardens. The species in the Plantation consist of a variety of local native trees and shrubs including: *Eucalyptus fibrosa* (Red Ironbark); *Eucalyptus crebra* (Narrow leaf Ironbark); *Eucalyptus tereticomis* (Forest Red Gum); *Eucalyptus moluccana* (Grey Box); *Corymbia maculata* (Spotted Gum); *Casuarina glauca* (She Oak); *Melaleuca* sp (Paperbark); *Callistemon 'Endeavour'* (Red Bottlebrush); and *Araucaria heterophylla* (Hoop Pine).
- 26 Campbelltown, Kenny Hill Interchange: 900 *Poplars* and *Plane Trees* and 2000 *Eucalyptus* species planted by the Australian Army in 1993 and upgraded by the Mt Annan Botanic Gardens.
- ◆ Partridge VC Rest Area established 2003.
- 27 Avon Dam Interchange: Planting by the RTA.
- 28 Maldon Road Interchange: Planting by the RTA.
- ◆ Kenna VC Rest Area established 2012.
- 29 Aylmerton Interchange: 660 *Eucalyptus* species planted by the RTA in 1962.
- 30 Mittagong Bypass: 320 *Box Elders*, *Planes*, *Poplars* and *Red Oaks* planted by the RTA in 1992.
- 31 Mittagong Bypass, Welby: Sir Charles Moses Park established in 1989.
- A Maltings, Mittagong: Plantation of evergreen and deciduous trees on the left as you enter Mittagong. Established by Nattai Shire Council in 1959 on land donated in 1958 by Tooth and Co. Further trees around Mittagong planted from 1961 onwards.
- B Bowral: Mixed grove of deciduous trees planted in 1962 on the right hand side of Mittagong Road as you enter Bowral.
- C Moss Vale D Sutton Forest E Berrima

Throughout this area (C, D, E) there are 15 plantations containing evergreen and deciduous trees and shrubs established between 1956 and 1965.

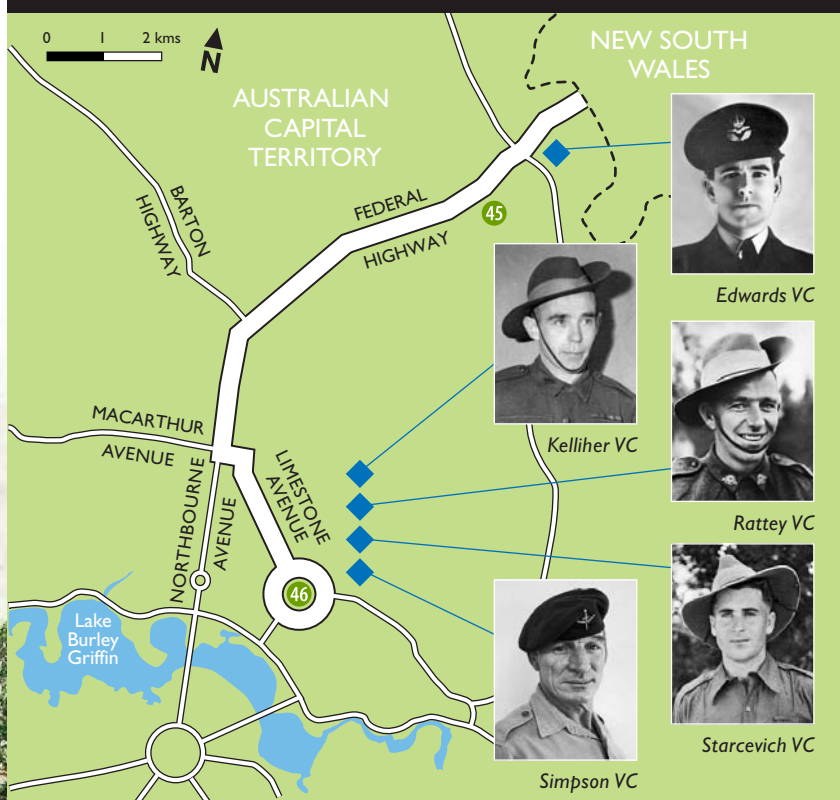
- 32 Berrima Bypass, Greenhills Road: Plantation of 270 *Cedars*, *Golden Oaks*, *Planes*, *Poplars* and *Elms*.
- ◆ Gordon VC Rest Area established 2001.
- ◆ Mackey VC Rest Area established 2001.
- 33 Illawarra Highway Interchange: 3000 *Eucalyptus* species, *Melaleucas* and *Hakeas* planted 1989-90.
- ◆ Kingsbury VC Rest Area established 1995.
- 34 Paddys River: Stands of native timber established on the western side of the Highway in 1954.
- ◆ Chowne VC Rest Area established 1997.
- 35 Towrang Creek: A grove of *Poplars*, *Gums*, *Oaks* and *Ashes* planted beside Towrang Creek at the old bridge site in 1955.
- ◆ Derrick VC Rest Area established 1999.
- 36 Goulburn Bypass: Plantations along the bypass with formal plantations at each end. Established by the RTA in 1993.

- 37 **Mulwaree High School:** Plantation established in 1998.
- ◆ **French VC Rest Area** established 1996.
- 38 **Hume Highway, Yarra:** A grove and rest area containing *Gums*, *Poplars* and *Willows* planted in 1956.
- 39 **Hume Highway, Yarra Interchange:** Plantations containing 850 *Poplars*, *Pin Oaks*, *Liquidambar* and *London Plane Trees* established in 1980.
- ◆ **Kibby VC Rest Area** established 1996.
- 40 **Federal Highway, Wollongorang Creek:** An avenue of *Plane Trees* along both sides of the carriageway to replace the existing avenue of established *Poplars*.
- 41 **Rose Lagoon:** Three hectares containing *Pines*, *Oaks*, *Cypresses*, *Gums*, *Poplars* and *Willows* established in 1957.
- ◆ **Edmondson VC Rest Area** established 1995.
- 42 **Collector Bypass, Winderadeen Hill:** Stands of native trees established in 1992.
- ◆ **Gratwick VC Rest Area** established 1996.
- 43 **Lake George:** A mature plantation including *Pines*, *Gums*, *Cypresses*, *Cedars*, *Oaks*, *Poplars* and *Elms* planted in 1954.
- ◆ **Gurney VC Rest Area** established 1995.
- ◆ **Badcoe VC Rest Area** established 1998/9.
- ◆ **Wheatley VC Rest Area** established 1998/9.
- ◆ **Anderson VC Rest Area** established 1998/9.
- 44 **Brooks Creek:** 4950 native trees and shrubs planted in 1989-90.
- ◆ **Middleton VC Rest Area** established 1997.
- ◆ **Newton VC Rest Area** established 1997.

- ◆ **Edwards VC Memorial Park** established 2000.
- 45 **Canberra District:** Five plantations along the Federal Highway in the ACT including *Gums*, *Pines*, *Oaks*, *Elms*, *Poplars*, *Willows* and *Wattles*. Planted from 1955 onwards.
- 46 **Australian War Memorial and Remembrance Park:** Three *Red Spotted Gums* planted in 2002 to mark the Canberra end of the driveway. Six *Red Spotted Gums* were also planted in 2002 to mark the service of past presidents of the Remembrance Driveway committee. A grove of *Allepo Pines* planted in Limestone Avenue in 1990.
- ◆ **Kelliher VC Memorial Park** established 2002.
- ◆ **Rattey VC Memorial Park** established 2002.
- ◆ **Simpson VC Memorial Park** established 2005.
- ◆ **Starcevic VC Memorial Park** established 2005.
